

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

### **TOWNSHIP OF PALMER NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

The following Ordinance shall resume on Tuesday, October 24, 2017, for a public hearing and considered for adoption by the Township of Palmer at a regular meeting of the Palmer Township Board of Supervisors, commencing at 7:00 p.m. in the meeting room of the Palmer Township Library at 3 Weller Place, Palmer Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania. This is a continuation of the public hearing which commenced on Tuesday, September 26, 2017.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PALMER TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE ARTICLE XVIII "SIGNS" IN ITS ENTIRETY AND SECTIONS 190-161, 190-173, 190-176.F, 190-180.B, 190-181.B, 190-183.1, 190-184, 190-185, 190-187, 190-189, 190-255, 190-267, 190-280, 190-299, 190-319 AND 190-339, AND TO ALLOW FOR AND REGULATE DIGITAL SIGNS AND ELECTRONIC MESSAGE SIGNS IN PALMER TOWNSHIP.**

**SINCE THE TIME OF THE FIRST PUBLIC HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 26, 2017, THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE HAS BEEN REVISED TO REFLECT THAT PROPOSED SECTION 190-187.H SHALL NOW REQUIRE THAT OFF PREMISES DIGITAL SIGNS MAY BE APPROVED AS A CONDITIONAL USE BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND REASONABLE CONDITIONS MAY ALSO BE IMPOSED AT THE TIME OF CONDITIONAL USE APPROVAL RATHER THAN BY SPECIAL EXCEPTION APPROVAL BY THE ZONING HEARING BOARD AS ORIGINALLY PROPOSED.**
