Pool Updates – McKinney – New manager at the pool, Palmer resident named Kevin Remaly (coach of Emmaus high school swim team) Ran Brookside Country Club pool for many years; our pool manager and assistant manager have resigned. The Palmer Swim team has disbanded. They cut a \$4600 check to Palmer Township. Was approached by the Wilson Swim team, get some of those kids and coaches here; will have Two Rivers swim team at Palmer. Using the old Palmer swim team time. 8-10am elite team, 10am-12pm for Palmer and Wilson. Team members will be required to have a Palmer Pool Pass. Information will be in the newsletter.

Recreation Development Fund - Nielsen – Copy of the Rec Budget, collected from multiple sources, development of land and homes and has regulation on where and how you spend it. Needs to be something to benefit the whole township, maintenance is allowed to an extent.

Bob Smith – On going build up project. We have a bond that will run out soon, so we will be using that for this year, allocated to the permit process for the field.

New Business – McKinney – Getting into a relationship with ENCO soccer \$15,000 a year to release the Fox Run fields for them. They will be aerating and fertilizing, and Palmer Township will cut the grass, this will be a two year lease. Bob Smith – The restrooms/storage are in the budget for that field. Riverview softball league \$8K a year. Could be In rec development fund. It is a line item in the budget. Groups renting our fields 1 and 3 for a tournament. Was originally just for park rentals.
