Notice is hereby given that the Palmer Township Board of Supervisors will consider for possible adoption an Ordinance, of which this Notice is a summary, amending Chapter 43 and Chapter 135 of the Code of Palmer Township by repealing them in their entirety. The Board will consider the Ordinance and hold a public hearing at its scheduled public meeting of Monday, May 15, 2023, at 7:00 p.m., in the Palmer Township Municipal Building, 3 Weller Place, Palmer, Pennsylvania 18045. Copies of the full text of the Ordinance are available for inspection at the Township offices and the offices of this newspaper during normal business hours. A summary of the proposed Ordinance is set forth below. ALL INTERESTED PARTIES ARE INVITED TO ATTEND.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PALMER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REPEALING CHAPTER 43 OF THE CODE OF PALMER TOWNSHIP RELATING TO A CENTRALIZED SYSTEM FOR ALARM SYSTEMS; REPEALING CHAPTER 135 RELATING TO REAL ESTATE REGISTRATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

The proposed Ordinance, which repeals in its entirety Chapter 43 and Chapter 135, is outlined below:

Section One – Repeals in its entirety and marks as “Reserved” Chapter 43 relating to a centralized system for alarm systems

Section Two – Repeals in its entirety and marks as “Reserved” Chapter 135 relating to real estate registration

Section Three – Provides a severability provision in the event the Ordinance or any part thereof is ruled unconstitutional

Section Four – Provides a conflicts provision and repeals all prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with this Ordinance

Section Five – Provides for an effective date of five (5) days after enactment
